Physical Agent Modalities (PAMs) for the Rehab Professional is designed to educate occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants in the use of electro-physical agents in the areas of electrical stimulation (pulsed, alternating, and direct current), and superficial and deep thermal agents. This course is also open PT/PTAs and Athletic Trainers (ATs).

The biophysical principles of each physical agent will be presented. The physiologic effects, indications, precautions and contraindications will be emphasized, along with the **best current practices**. The appropriate **selection** and **application** of physical agents, based on the existing pathology, impairments, and functional limitations will be **discussed, demonstrated by participants**. Safe and effective parameter selection, **dosing** of intensity, and **documentation** of treatment will be emphasized during the lecture and laboratory portions of the course.

This course will prepare the participant in the theory and clinical application of transcutaneous electrical stimulation (TENS), neuromuscular electrical stimulation (NMES), functional electrical stimulation (FES), iontophoresis, phonophoresis, and continuous and pulsed therapeutic ultrasound. The course includes **lectures, laboratory sessions and case studies**.

NOTE: Please bring lab attire that allows for access to the shoulders (e.g. loose fitting t-shirt or tank top).
